One important item that still needs to be clarified and that of providing AWC with proof of payment for medical bills. At the moment AWC say they will ask for proof of payment for dental bills over €2000 and optician's bills of over €500. However, they still have the right to ask for proof of payment in all cases. So my advice to you is to keep all bills and receipts for two years until there is a definite ruling on this item. Additionally to ensure that AWC reimburse in reasonable time you should submit your proof of payment with the claim in the event of a dental bill of over €2000 or a optician's bill of over €500. There has been some discussion with AWC as to what they consider proof of payment these problems are being dealt with on a case by case basis meanwhile keep all receipts and relevant bank payments until we get further clarification from AWC.
